

**American Board of Preventive Medicine and  
American Board of Emergency Medicine  
Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine  
Practice Pathway Ends June 30, 2010**

The American Board of Preventive Medicine (ABPM) will administer the certifying examination in Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine between October 4 and October 15, 2010. Physicians may apply through one of three pathways – ACGME-accredited fellowship training in Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine, unaccredited fellowship training in Undersea and Hyperbaric Medicine, and practice-plus-training. Application through the unaccredited fellowship training and the practice-plus-training pathways will end June 30, 2010.

Diplomates of the ABPM must submit applications through ABPM. Diplomates of ABEM must submit applications through ABEM. Physicians with primary certification in both Emergency Medicine and Preventive Medicine may apply through either board. Both boards will accept applications submitted from March 1 through June 30, 2010. Diplomates certified by an ABMS Board other than ABPM or ABEM must submit applications through the ABPM.
